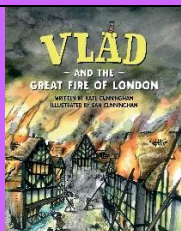


Newchurch Community Primary School - Share in our learning...Year 1 Autumn B

English:

Reading:



Our class text is **Vlad and the Great Fire of London** by **Kate Cunningham**. The story follows the journey of a rat and his friend the flea as they find themselves in the midst of one of London's most famous historical events.

We will write our own **diary account** based on the events.



Writing:

We will be using our class text to focus on the following targets in our grammar and writing:

- Compose a sentence orally before writing it
- Combine words to make sentences
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Leave spaces between words
- Discuss what they have written with adults and peers
- Re-read what they have written to check it makes sense
- Use capital letters for the names of people and the personal pronoun 'I'
- Begin to use capital letters and full stops

Mathematics:

Along with our arithmetic and calculation skills we will be looking at the following areas of the curriculum:

We will be looking to master a wide range of targets linked to these areas, such as:

- Exploring the part-whole model
- Number bonds to 10
- Adding together
- Subtracting by taking away, crossing out, counting back and finding the difference
- Fact families
- Comparing addition and subtraction statements
- Recognising and naming 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Sorting 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers to 20 in numerals and words
- Exploring tens and ones
- Comparing and ordering numbers

Science:

Our scientific studies will focus on **Seasonal Changes**.

We will be exploring the four seasons and the key events and changes that occur in each one. We will focus on Autumn and Winter, in particular, and compare different trees, observing how they change across the seasons.

We will look at different types of weather in each season and perform simple tests to investigate weather that we experience e.g. how wind changes in strength and direction over the course of a week.

Dance

We will be exploring a range of dance moves and how

these can be used to express different feelings. We will examine how the mood of different music can be used to represent parts of a story and create our own dance routine to match the music and retell the events of the Great Fire of London.

Art:

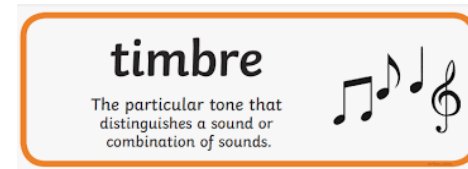


Our art unit is **painting**. We will be looking at naming colours and experimenting with colour mixing. We will explore and use a range of tools to apply colour to our artwork.
