

The story of a young boy who accidentally stumbles back in time to the Stone Age! He encounters new people, new creatures and new ways of life as he explores.




Roz the robot is stranded on an island. Using her powers of observation and robot brain, she learns skills from the animals around her.

Writing: We will be using our class texts to focus on the following targets in our grammar and writing:

- Group ideas into paragraphs
- Build a varied and rich vocabulary
- Use prepositions to express, time, place and cause.
- Introduce inverted commas to punctuate direct speech.

Mathematics: Along with our arithmetic and calculation skills we will be looking at the following areas of the curriculum:



We will be looking to master a wide range of targets linked to these areas, such as:

- Represent numbers to 100
- Tens and ones using addition
- Hundreds
- Number lines to 100
- Numbers to 1,000
- 100s, 10s, and 1s
- Find 1,10, 100 more or less
- Compare objects and number
- Order numbers
- Count in 50s
