### Re: School Uniform

Unfortunately, we have noticed that there has been a slip in the presentation of the children's school uniform with some children wearing red hoodies rather than red jumpers, fleeces or cardigans. It has been brought to my attention that parents think this has been authorised by school so please can we assure you that it has not, and does not meet the school uniform policy.

The only class allowed to wear red hoodies are our Year 6 children who wear their Leavers' hoodies throughout the year to ensure they get their wear out of them and also to give them something special in their final year.

As detailed on the school website and in our uniform policy, the school uniform is as such:

#### School Uniform

Red sweatshirt or cardigan (available with or without a logo)  
White polo shirt (available with or without a logo)  
Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore  
Black shoes  
Grey, white or black socks  
Red tights  
Red gingham dress/skorts in the summer term

#### PE Kits

Red polo shirt (available with or without a logo)  
Black joggers and hoodie (for outdoor PE)  
Black shorts or skorts  
Trainers

As you can see, black hoodies are acceptable for PE as they are sports wear.
